## WE ARE HERE TO HELP BUILD BRIDGES

When your child is having problems at school, this is naturally a worrying time for all involved. Until recently exclusion to home was often the only alternative. This caused disruption to their education and meant that you had to make arrangements for their care through the day. This has now changed.

FDR@MAEPS offers a First Day Response provision to students at a risk of, or as an alternative to, exclusion. FDR@MAEPS is part of the MAEPS (Moorbridge Alternative Education Partnership School). FDR@MAEPS is based in Blanchard Terrace, North Shields next to the Linskill Centre.

Students are expected to travel independently. The nearest Metro station is North Shields which is approximately a 15 minute walk. There are bus stops at The Gunner and on Linskill Terrace.

The staff in FDR@MAEPS have extensive experience of working with young people experiencing difficulties in school. The students will carry out work provided by the school or set internally thus minimising the disruption to their education.

We are an alternative Provision School working with young people who may be at a time in their lives that they require specific support. This is often when they are encountering personal crisis, when they require support with anxieties, barriers to learning, behaviour or when they are not medically well enough to attend school.

We are extremely proud of our curriculum, nurturing approach and the impact of our service and know that we can deliver a provision for young people whatever their need.

FDR is a service paid for by schools for schools. The short term provision is specifically for pupils who are struggling in mainstream school and need some additional support in order for them to maintain their place in their mainstream school.
